

# Vacancy for a Research Fellow

## Modern history of markets/exchange

Max Weber Stiftung, Delhi, is looking for

### **a post-doctoral research fellow.**

The post shall begin earliest on 1 February 2025. It is a fixed-term vacancy, which following the successful completion of a probation period of 6 months, would end after 1 year. The position is not extendable.

Max Weber Stiftung is a public-funded, German humanities and social science research foundation with institutes and branch offices in North America, Europe, and Asia. It was established in India in 2014 to engage in Indo-German collaborative research in the humanities and social sciences and to provide support to Indo-German research networks and collaborations in these fields. In India, MWS has developed a strong research profile in the history and anthropology of markets as part of its “Economy and Knowledge” focus area. It promotes both interdisciplinary and transnational approaches in research on the South Asian region. As a German research institution in India, MWS is eligible for third-party funding from German and EU funding agencies.

The position is intended to allow the research fellow to work on a grant application as part of their postdoctoral career phase. If successful, grants can be located either at MWS in India, or in association with MWS at a research institution located in Germany. The research fellow will independently complete and submit a grant application at the funding agency of their choice, within the field outlined above. Within the broad field of the history of markets and exchange in South Asia in the modern period, we are particularly looking for applications that cover one or more of the following topics – trust and risk, speculation and gambling, entrepreneurial decision-making, and regulation. An emphasis on the Arabian Sea littoral region in South Asia and a potential for extending research to the wider Indian Ocean region constitute added advantages.

The fellow will report directly and be accountable to the Director, Max Weber Stiftung, Delhi.

Tasks shall include but not be limited to the following:

- Independently complete and submit a third-party grant application on the topics outlined above
- Participating in academic activities of Max Weber Stiftung, Delhi
- Undertaking other research related tasks as necessary and as agreed with the Director

Qualifications, Skills and Experience:

- Ph.D. degree in History
- Experience in conducting historical research
- Experience in carrying out research projects independently
- Knowledge of the German and international research landscape would be an added advantage but not essential
- Experience in disseminating research output nationally and/or internationally

The starting salary would be INR 1,56,780 based on the salary scheme of the Embassy of Federal Republic of Germany in New Delhi.

The successful candidate will be employed by Max Weber Stiftung, which is a family- friendly, equal opportunity employer dedicated to fostering workplace equality for men and women. In our selection procedures, we carefully consider the individual interests of all applicants. Where candidates are equal in terms of suitability, competence and professional performance, we fill the advertised position in accordance with the Federal Equal Opportunities Act (Bundesgleichstellungsgesetz) and, in the case of persons with a significant disability as defined in German law, in accordance with the Federal Social Code Act (SGB IX). To the extent possible, flexibility of working hours will be considered.

- 3) 3 academic references (the names of the 3 referees along with their affiliations and emails would be sufficient)
- 4) Brief summary of research agenda in the history of markets/exchange
- 5) Project description (maximum 2 pages)
- 6) Copy of Ph.D. degree or a letter from supervisor/department head confirming all requirements for the Ph.D. degree will have been completed at the latest by the commencement of the position.
